Council News-May 2022

Council met on Tuesday, May 11, 2022 at 7:00pm in person and via Zoom.

Council welcomed new members Paul Economy, Daniel Hickox-Young, and Patti Henkel and also Donna Wright for a second term. As Council began team building as a new group moments of experienced grace ranging from engaging conversations in the grocery store, to a myriad of the color green on display in creation, to daily morning meditation (to only name a few) were explored.

The following officers were elected: President Shannon Radmacher and Vice-President Paul Economy.

Officially appointed are Peter Shick as Treasurer, David Mellon as Financial Secretary and Karen Lowdon as Secretary.
Gary Sahm reported on Stewardship and Building a Culture of Generosity. Intent Sunday is May 22 with a goal of 70 intent cards turned in.

The Treasurer's report showed receipts for the month ending April 20, 2022 of \$17,724 and YTD \$87,707 which is \$13,859 under YTD budget. Expenses for April were \$23,403 and YTD \$96,979. St. Philip's YTD expenses have exceeded budget by \$3,440 and exceeded income by \$10,262. \$25,000 from investments has been transferred to facilitate cash flow. Receipts are about \$1000/week less than before COVID. That means giving amount and the number of contributors have both decreased since the beginning of COVID in March 2020.

The Office Administrator job has been posted and a few applications have been received. A celebration to thank Laura Weatherford Burns will be held June 19 after worship.

Pastor Laura reported that "Acts on the Road" a study similar to Stations of the Cross, will be taking place each Sunday in May with travel to different parts of the valley after worship on Sunday morning.

Digital ministry continues via Facebook and videos about different areas of ministry are being posted.

Pastor Laura's husband Luke Swanson has been called as Pastor at Trinity Lutheran in Roanoke and will be ordained June 18.

Pastor David reported that Grace Upon Grace focus will continue through the summer. The importance of teamwork has been highlighted with the change of administrator.

The next council meeting will be June 14 at 7:00 pm in person and via Zoom.

Celebrating Pentecost

Pentecost Sunday will be June 5th. It's a special Sunday where we remember how the Holy Spirit descended as tongues of fire, people could understand one another's languages, and the church was born!
