# St. Philip Participates in Habitat for Humanity Apostles Build

On July 22 folks from St. Philip added our efforts to the ongoing construction of the Apostles Build Habitat house. Our combined work with many others is bringing to be Aubrey's dream to have her own home.

Check out the progress of the 2023 Apostles Build! The siding has gone on, insulation has been placed and it is ready for wall board and plaster. The exterior has gone quickly and we are now moving on to the slower, more meticulous inside work. All in all, Aubrey's house is going great.

On an interesting note, Aubrey was able to meet the Governor of Virginia in Richmond in early July. A friend of Aubrey's works with The Lampstand. This mission received an award from Governor Youngkin, and Aubrey was able to join her friend for the presentation. The Lampstand is a ministry of Straight Street, a non-profit in Roanoke, and it provides a residential safe-home and comprehensive care for female victims of sexual trafficking. They also provide education so everyone can prevent, identify and report human trafficking.

Straight Street is a ministry that was founded by and is still directed by Keith Farmer, son of Ruth and brother of Kevin Farmer of St. Philip!!
